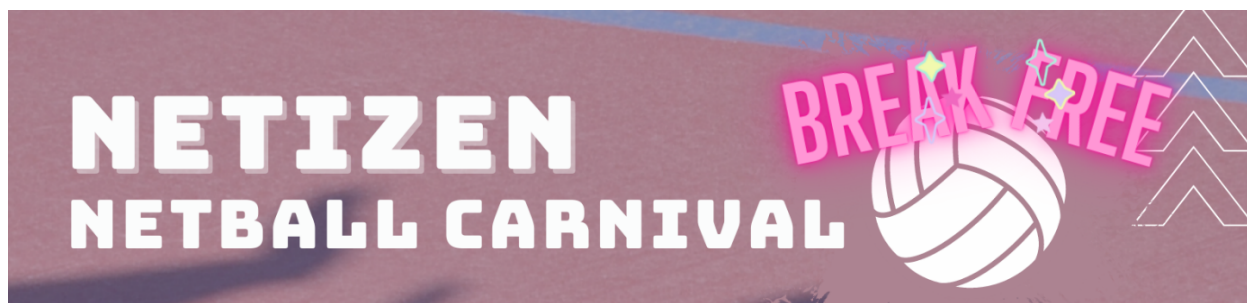

How are we different from other carnivals?

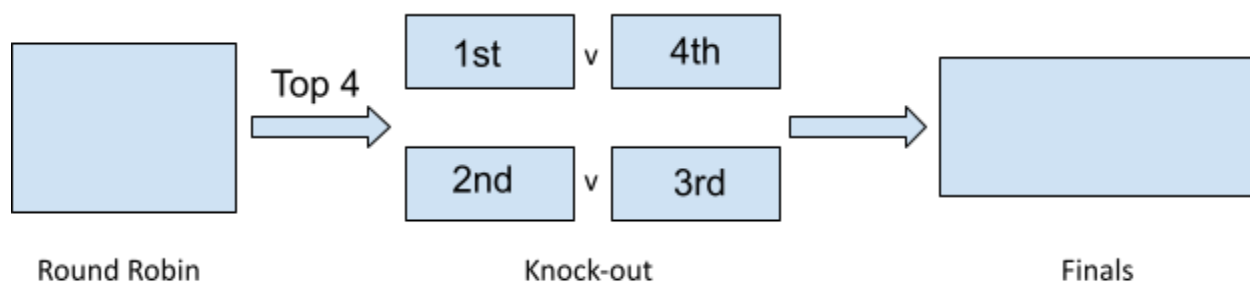
- **FUN** - Come have fun, make new friends, learn from each other and create a supportive, fun and encouraging environment for everyone. Lots of netball games! Plus mini game booths and prizes to be won!
- **SPORTSMANSHIP & CARE**
 - Older age group will be expected to self-umpire the games (guided by volunteer umpires)
 - You will be expected to come up with unique cheers everytime you finish a game. Points/prizes will be given to the best cheers. Cheer Leader to lead.
 - Nominate Most Valuable Player (MVP) after each game. Someone who displayed exemplary sports values, not necessarily the most skilful.
- **LEADERSHIP** - You will be expected to take charge, organize and manage yourselves as much as possible by sharing roles and responsibility within the team e.g. team cap, logistics in charge etc. Refer to the **Registration Form**.



Carnival Must Know

1. Format of Play

- All games will be played full court 7 v 7.
- Round Robin Format will be used for the 1st round. Top 4 shall proceed to the 2nd round.
- Knock Out Format will be used for 2nd rd. Winners will proceed to Finals.
- All games are played in 7 mins per half with immediate change over.
- Round Robin Point System – Win 2 points, Draw 1 point, Loss 0 point



- Substitution can occur anytime after a center pass is scored. No limit of the number of substitutions made in a game.
- It will be central timing. No stoppage or extra injury time will be given.
- Sports Values reserves the right to change the Game Format to suit the number of teams entered and the Carnival duration, without prior notice
- Umpires will be applying the latest INF new rules 2020 for all categories.

2. Prizes and Giveaways

- Prizes worth up to \$300 will be awarded to the top 2 teams for both categories
- There will also be other awards given to e.g. Best Cheer, Most Caring Team, Most Organized Team, Top 10 Influencers, Most Valuable Players etc

3. Registration Form & Team List

- Each team shall register a minimum of 7 players and no more than 10 players.
- Please clearly indicate who is your Team Captain, Team Manager, Logistics In Charge etc in your **Registration Form**.
- Teams are required to submit their entries on the official entry form by the closing date.

6. Scoring and Time Keeping

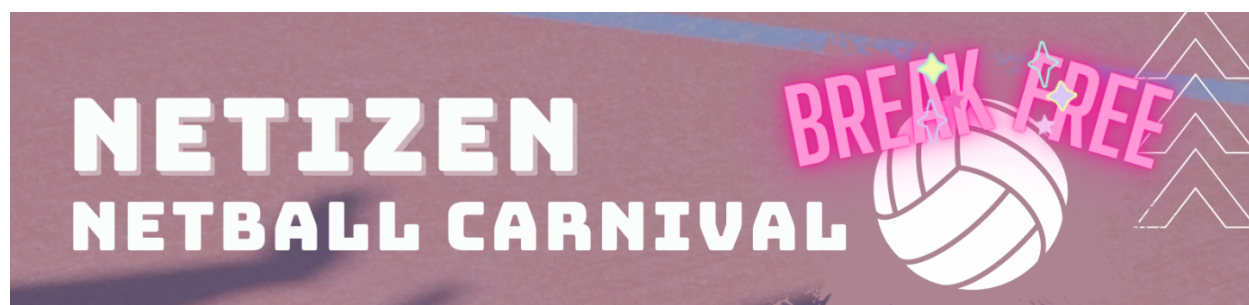
- Each team must have 1 scorer at each match and they must stand together.
- Team Managers must request the Umpires to verify the scores on the scorecards and submit immediately to the Carnival Officials Bench.

7. First Aid & Insurance

- Team are to provide their own first aid kit and ice packs to treat injuries.
- All players are advised to purchase personal accident insurance.

8. Liability

- Sports Values and its sponsors shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries or losses of personal properties that may have been suffered during this event.
- All photos taken during the event may be used for Sports Values's publicity and advertising campaigns.

Step #2 - Key in the details of each team member

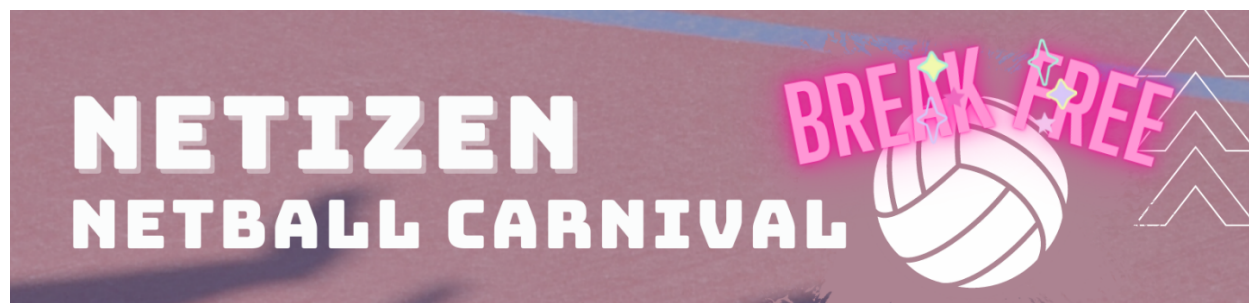

	Description of Leadership Roles & Responsibilities You Can Choose From
Team Captain	Submit the form and be the main contact person. Keep the team together by being a role model. Strongest person in terms of mindset and able to give skills and game advice to the team. Initiate team talk and guide the team to set meaningful goals. Conduct pre game briefing, lead warm up and facilitate debrief after the game.
Team Manager	Is like the Teacher In Charge of the team. Coordinate the submission of forms working with Team Captain. Someone who makes sure the team knows exactly where to be and when. Coordinate meeting time, warm up time, take scorecards, submit scorecards, check scores and ensure the team nominates MVPs after each match.
Logistics IC	To coordinate the bringing (what to bring and who to bring) of all logistics needed for that day. Prepare the list beforehand, borrow from available sources if necessary. On the carnival day, make sure all the equipment is accounted for at all times throughout the carnival. Make sure what you bring are brought back!
Social Media IC	A social media expert who will be In charge of taking pictures/videos, posting stories and documenting their team's journey throughout the carnival. Helping the team capture valuable memories and fun moments in order to make this carnival a memorable one.
Cheer Leader	A very creative and fun loving person who takes charge of coming up with interesting cheers and leading the team to show sportsmanship and respect to the other teams.
Trainee Umpire	Interested to learn more about umpiring and would like to practice umpiring skills under the guidance of our volunteer umpires. For U17s category, you will be the ones taking turns to umpire the games.
Player	It is also perfectly fine to just be a player - someone who simply wants to focus on playing netball well.

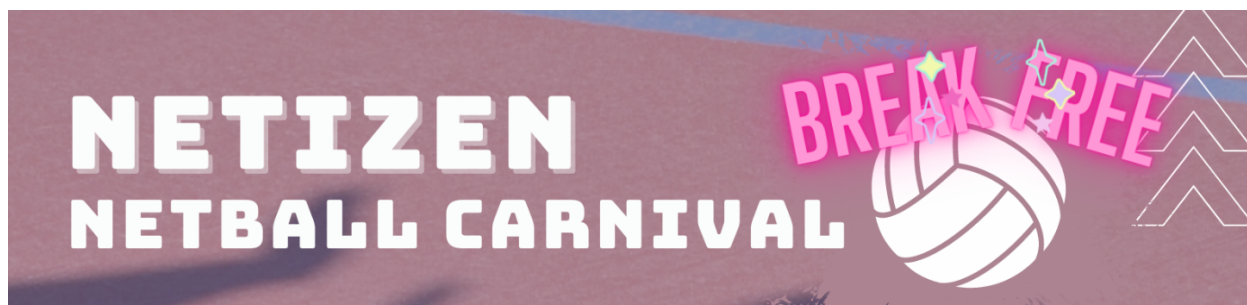
